

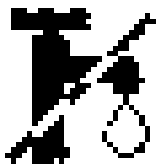
Bordeaux Blue Sage



Salvia nemerosa 'Bordeaux Blue'

- **Use:** Beautiful, bold, dark blue flower spikes start blooming early and rebloom throughout the summer. Especially effective in mass plantings, but also nice for mixed borders and containers. Loved by pollinators. From the Salvia Sensation Series. Excellent in the front of the border or in a container. Combine with yellow tones of Rudbeckia to provide pleasing contrasts.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Good drainage a must. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Reaches 16-24" tall and 18-24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fragrant, green leaves.
- **Flower:** Lush spikes of violet opening to deep purple blue. Long blooming from early spring to fall frosts. Trim off old flowers for repeat blooming.
