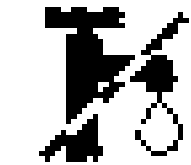


# Caradonna Sage



## *Salvia nemerosa* 'Caradonna'

- **Use:** Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant. Has a wonderful compact habit that makes this perennial an excellent choice for containers. A new look for an old time favorite and hummingbirds and butterflies love it!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** It has a plant height of 18" and a spread of 12-15" and stays in excellent compact form.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** It has dark red stems loaded with purple flowers that bloom from June to September. After the flowers fade little seed pods appear making this a truly unique variety. Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant and for the most blooms.
