

# Caramia Meadow Sage



## *Salvia nemerosa* 'Caramia'

- **Use:** Developed to improve upon Caradonna. Caramia boasts three times more blossoms and a growth habit that is much more compact. Dark purple flowers on dark stems. Especially effective in mass plantings, but also nice for mixed borders and containers. Loved by pollinators.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Good drainage a must. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Reaches 14-18 in. wide, 14-16 in. tall, in bloom.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fragrant, green leaves.
- **Flower:** Blooms early on dark, 8-10 in. stems that hold deep ultraviolet blue flower spikes from spring until fall.

Easy to grow and comes back every year. Enjoy 5+ months of flowers.
