

Dwarf Blue Queen Salvia



Salvia nemerosa 'Dwarf Blue Queen'

- **Use:** Deep blue spikes on a free flowering compact dwarf plant. Vigorous and broad enough for any size garden, especially useful if you need a blue in the foreground. Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Easy to grow and attracts hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Must have good drainage. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 12" tall and 18" wide in one season..
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with beautiful blue flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.

Looking for a summer show of intense color? Easy to grow, salvias perform best in full sun.
