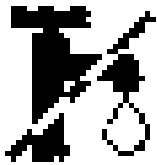


# Noble Knight Sage



## *Salvia nemerosa* 'Noble Knight'

- **Use:** A compact habit, great branching and early flowering sweeten the deal. Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant. Has a wonderful compact habit that makes this perennial an excellent choice for containers. A new look for an old time favorite and hummingbirds and butterflies love it!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** It has a plant height of 12-18" and a spread of 12-15" and stays in excellent compact form.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9 Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Large purple-to-blue flowers may catch your eye, but the plants' flower power is what will give you the most happiness in your garden. Thick, weather-tolerant flowers are self-cleaning but the plant remains attractive even when the petals do fall. Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant and for the most blooms.
