

Blue Hill Salvia



Salvia sylvestris 'Blue Hill'

- **Use:** Excellent in containers or in your perennial border. Easy to grow and attracts hummingbirds. Fairly drought tolerant once established and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 15-18" tall and wide in one season.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with beautiful blue flowers that are just outstanding! Nonstop profusion of color from April until late October! Trim back occasionally to keep a tidy plant.

Easy to grow and comes back every year.
