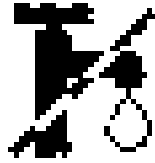


# Autumn Fire Sedum

## *Sedum x 'Autumn Fire'*

- **Use:** Bold clusters of closely packed, rosy pink flowers appear in late summer, age to a salmon bronze and finish with a deep coppery red in fall. An easy-to-grow plant that not only tolerates drought, but seems to thrive in it. The sturdy stems of Autumn Fire keep it beautifully intact throughout its bloom period for an outstanding show! It is also a great butterfly attractor and is disease resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' high and 2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Succulent green to dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Rich rosy-pink flowers age to coppery red atop the sturdy stems and provide long-lasting late season color. An improvement over the popular 'Autumn Joy' with deeper, longer lasting flowers and hardier, sturdier stems. Good fresh or dried for arrangements.
