

# 1 gal Chocolate Ball Sedum



## *Sedum 'Chocolate Ball'*

- **Use:** A terrific low evergreen groundcover for sunny areas with poor dry soil. When planted in containers or on a wall this develops a beautiful cascading habit. A new small sedum with entirely delicious, needled foliage -- like a teeny conifer -- in dark green with hints of black in summer, adding in dark red brown -- think chocolate -- in cold weather. A great groundcover for sun, well-drained soil, and occasional summer water for best appearance. Does well in large rock gardens where the plants can be given room to spread. Best with occasional to no foot traffic. Drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. Prefers well-drained soil, but it will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Spreads to only 6-8" tall spreading to 12-14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Ranging in color from milk-chocolate brown in the spring to dazzling red in the fall, this sedum looks gorgeous all year round.
- **Flower:** Clusters of yellow starry flowers appear during the summer.

**Drought tolerant and so easy to grow! Very good at controlling weeds also.**
