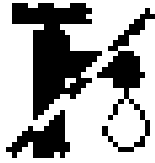


# Frosted Fire Stonecrop



## *Sedum 'Frosted Fire'*

- **Use:** A variegated sport of 'Autumn Fire' rather than 'Autumn Joy'. This plant shares the same brightly colored rosy flower heads, tighter growth habit, and thicker foliage as 'Autumn Fire'. Tall, upright sedums form substantial clumps of foliage which can be substituted for shrubs in the landscape.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but it will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15" tall and 18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Light green leaves with creamy yellow, serrated margins form a dense, upright mound.
- **Flower:** Their stout, sturdy stems support the massive creamy flower heads which develop in summer and burst into bloom and turn a rosy red in fall. If left standing, they provide winter interest and food for birds
