

Little Miss Sunshine Stonecrop



Sedum 'Little Miss Sunshine' PP30039

- **Use:** These low, spreading sedums form a solid mat of foliage which is excellent for covering slopes or can be planted as a groundcover in sunny, dry areas. They are extremely drought tolerant and many are evergreen. These are terrific low-maintenance plants that always look their best.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. Prefers well-drained soil, but it will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-8" tall & 18-20" wide, but continues to spread.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Prized for its incredibly dark green, glossy foliage
- **Flower:** From early to midsummer, tiny clusters of yellow flowers cover the polished habit.

Drought tolerant and so easy to grow! Very good at controlling weeds also.
