## *Sedum 'Mojave Jewels Diamond'*

- **Use:** Tired of dark foliated Sedums with weak, floppy stems? Get ready for this beauty featuring unique, strong, upright stems that are perfect for holding aloft its beautiful rose-red flower clusters. These late summer-blooming flowers are outstanding but its the year-round deep, dark bluish-red foliage color that is just as thrilling adding even more red color in a hot sunny spot. Excellent in the landscape, rock garden and container plantings; makes a great groundcover. Prefers dry, well-drained soil in full sun. Deer resistant, drought tolerant, and attracts butterflies!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15" tall and 18-20" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Stiff purple stems, foliage dark gray-green at first, turning dark purple in the sun.
- **Flower:** Candy pink flowers in late fall are a favorite of pollinators. It does not flare out during flowering. Can also be sued as a cut flower.
