

Coral Carpet Sedum



Drought tolerant and so easy to grow! Very good at controlling weeds also.

***Sedum album* 'Coral Carpet'**

- **Use:** Small, fleshy leaves are coral when new, maturing to green and becoming reddish bronze in winter. Small, star-shaped white flowers appear above the foliage. A vigorous groundcover or rock garden subject. Good winter effect. Useful for planting in green roofs or in rock walls. Short enough to use between flagstones in a patio or walkway.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. Prefers well-drained soil, but it will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Mat forming, to 3 in. tall and 1-2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 2-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. It forms a low carpet of small, rounded green leaves that are clustered together like little beads, taking on rich red tones in summer and winter.
- **Flower:** Tiny, star-shaped, white flowers bloom in July-August on stems rising to 4-5" tall.
