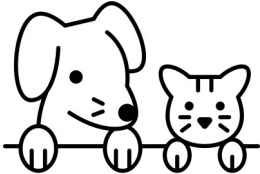
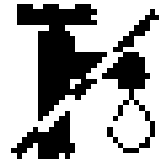


Fine Gold Leaf Stonecrop

- **Use:** Sedum Fine Leaf Gold has pointy needle-like foliage that creates a blanket of chartreuse star bursts. Though not the focal point for this succulent, small star shaped flowers bloom in the spring. Enjoy as a houseplant in a sunny window for a pop of color or outdoors when temps are above 50 degrees in warmer months.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Best in full sun to partial light indoors (low light and it will turn green). It prefers dry to average moisture levels with very well-drained soil, and will often die in standing water. It is considered to be drought-tolerant, and thus makes an ideal choice for a low-water garden or xeriscape application. It is not particular as to soil pH, but grows best in poor soils, and is able to handle environmental salt.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-12" tall and 8-12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual or Houseplant Bring indoors in winter when temps below 50
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Short, fleshy, needle-like, chartreuse foliage.
- **Flower:** The white flowers in midsummer are nearly unnoticeable against the golden foliage.
