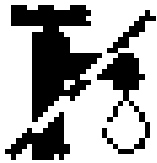


Russian Stonecrop



Sedum kamtschaticum

- **Use:** This tough, drought-tolerant species has glossy deep green leaves and, in early summer, half-inch golden yellow flowers that open from pink buds. It grows to about 6 inches tall and a little wider and makes a good groundcover.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but it will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 6" tall and 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Succulent, dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Long-lasting, star-like, golden yellow flowers.
