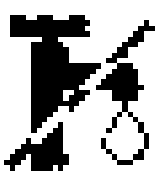


Variegated Russian Stonecrop



Sedum kamtschaticum variegatum

- **Use:** This is compact growing form that has fairly large leaves that have cream colored variegation on the margins that takes on a hint of pink in the full sun.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 6" tall and 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Succulent, dark green leaves edged in creamy variegation.
- **Flower:** The yellow flowers and pink to orange-red car-pels appear on plants at the same time giving this a truly 'tricolor' appearance.
