


Blue Spruce Sedum



Drought tolerant and so easy to grow! Perfect for edging a driveway where the temperatures can top 100F.

Sedum reflexum 'Blue Spruce'

- **Use:** The steel blue foliage and yellow flowers on this fast growing ground cover make it the perfect choice for those poor-soil conditions. Thrives on neglect and easily adapts to soils ranging from pure sand to solid clay, but of course prefers sandy soils. Attractive used as a ground cover or planted in a rock wall and drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs to be planted in full sun in well-drained soil. It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows to 8" tall and can spread to form a colorful low-growing matt to 20" across.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Thin bluish-green leaves.
- **Flower:** Masses of bright yellow flowers stand atop the silvery blue foliage in spring to summer.
