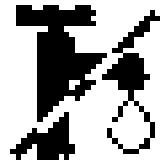


# Prima Angelina Stonecrop



**Striking needle-shaped leaves in a brilliant, golden yellow color. Wonderful as a groundcover or in a rock garden. Drought tolerant and so easy to grow! Very good at controlling weeds also.**



## *Sedum rupestre* 'Prima Angelina'

- **Use:** Brilliant chartreuse-yellow, needle-like foliage forms a quick groundcover. Adds cheery color to containers, dry slopes and flowering borders. Excellent for use as year-round coverage for beds with spring bulbs. Drought tolerant. This cultivar is a more dense and compact, a brighter yellow foliage that Angelina and somewhat slower in growth, but still strong growth.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. Prefers well-drained soil, but it will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-6" tall and 6-8" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-11; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen (in GA) Forms a trailing mat of succulent golden-yellow leaves. Brighter yellow color that holds stronger yellow thru winter than Angelina.
- **Flower:** Clusters of yellow starry flowers appear during the summer.
