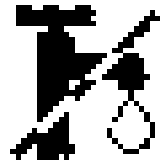


# Golddigger Stonecrop



Striking needle-shaped leaves in a brilliant, golden yellow color. Wonderful as a groundcover or in a rock garden. Drought tolerant and so easy to grow! Very good at controlling weeds also.



## *Sedum sexangulare* 'Golddigger'

- **Use:** A prolific ground cover succulent with foliage that turns gold in full sun. It has variable foliage that can be emerald green to nearly fire orange and everything in between. The flowers of this plant are yellow and emerge intermittently amongst the clump. Drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. Prefers well-drained soil, but It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-6" tall and 6-8" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-11; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen (in GA) This cultivar is a more dense and compact, a brighter yellow foliage that Angelina and somewhat slower in growth, but still strong growth.
- **Flower:** Clusters of yellow starry flowers appear during the summer.
