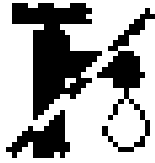


5" Stonecrop



Sedum 'Autumn Joy'

- **Use:** 'Autumn Joy' is a great choice for beds and borders and excellent as cut flowers. It is also a great butterfly attractor and is disease resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but it will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 18"-20" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Succulent, dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Flower heads form in July and the flat corymbs look like broccoli. In August, the flowers start to color up, turning pink. Slowly the flowers turn red, and later in fall they turn a deeper rusty-red.
