

# Fulda Glow Stonecrop



Low, spreading sedums form a solid mat of foliage which is excellent for covering slopes

or can be planted as a groundcover in sunny, dry areas. They are extremely drought tolerant and many are evergreen. These are terrific low-maintenance plants that always look their best.



## *Sedum spurium 'Fuldaglut'*

- **Use:** Touted as an improved 'Dragon's Blood', this selection sports attractive bronze-red foliage that keeps its color all season long. Rose-red flowers appear on short stalks above the foliage in late summer. A mass planting of 'Fulda Glow' is stunning.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. Prefers well-drained soil, but it will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6" tall and 10" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Lustrous ruby red foliage.
- **Flower:** Hot pink flowers in late summer to fall.
