

Tricolor Creeping Sedum



Drought tolerant and so easy to grow! An excellent ground-cover!



Sedum spurium 'Tricolor'

- **Use:** Rock gardens, borders, edging, under shady trees and steep banks will come alive with carefree color of the Creeping Tricolor Sedum. Tolerant of dry infertile soils and is useful for covering difficult places and providing erosion control on banks.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs to be planted in full sun in well-drained soil. It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 4" tall and spreads 18-24" wide. Place these hardy plants about 1' apart. They fill troublesome areas with neat 3-4" tall cover. Spreads fast. Does not need pruning.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen foliage, even in sub-zero weather. Green, pink, and red foliage.
- **Flower:** Bright hot pink, star like flowers cover the plant from June through September.
