Conga Line Sedum


















Sedum telephium 'Conga Line' PPAF

- <u>Use:</u> Strong upright stems are covered in multicolored foliage topped with lovely peach, coral and cream flowers in late summer. Foliage colors shift from green and purple to warm burgundy tones during flowering. Short, compact habit keeps this plant from opening up over the years. A champion pollinator attractor also!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth**: Grows 16-20" tall and 16" wide.
- *Hardiness*: Zone 3-9; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Succulent foliage evolves from green to purple to burgundy.
- **Flower:** Late summer brings flower clusters of peach, coral, and cream. Good fresh or dried for arrangements.
