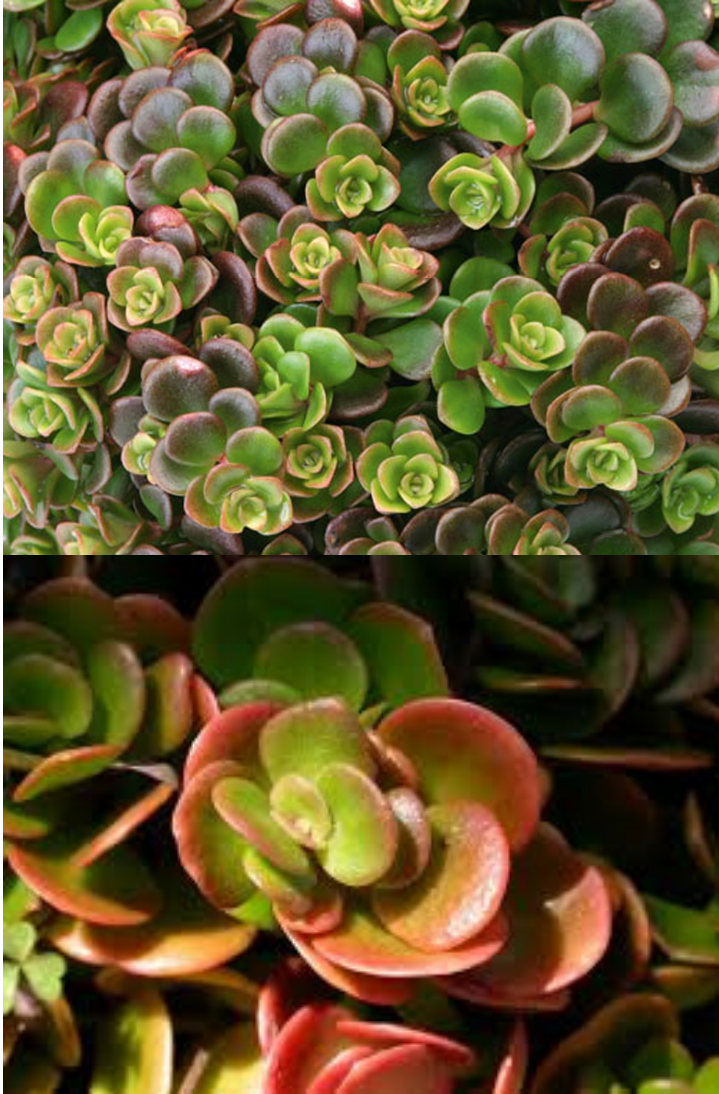


# Coral Reef Sedum



## *Sedum tetractinum* 'Coral Reef'

- **Use:** This mat-forming Succulent turns a showy bronze and burgundy color in fall. Its trailing stems hold round leaves that form rosettes at the tips. Starry flowers dot the foliage in late summer, followed by russet seed capsules for year-round interest.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. Prefers well-drained soil, but It will tolerate most soil types and is drought resistant.
- **Growth:** Grows 3" tall & 12" wide, but continues to spread.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Small green leaves turn bronze in winter.
- **Flower:** Tiny, star-shaped, white to pale pink flowers (to 3/4") bloom in July-August on stems rising to 4-5" tall.

**Drought tolerant and so easy to grow! Very good at controlling weeds also.**
