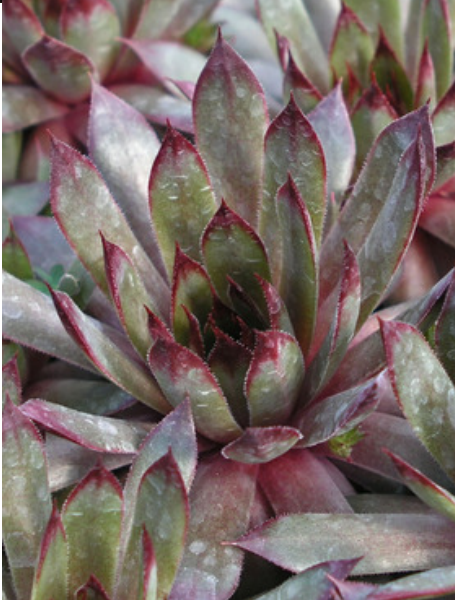


Red Beauty Hens and Chicks

Sempervivum 'Red Beauty'

- **Use:** Gray-green foliage of open rosettes are tipped deep red. Will spread slowly to form a thick mat. Tiny new plants appear around the mother in the middle. Red Beauty produces short spikes of pink flowers mid summer. Excellent for rock gardens and containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil, and is very drought tolerant. Needs very little fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 4" tall and 1' wide. Spreads more over time, but not invasive.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Succulent leaves grow in a rosette of gray-green leaves with red tips.
- **Flower:** Clusters of light pink flowers in midsummer.
