**Excellent groundcover
for months of blossoms
in late spring through summer .**

Silene 'Carol Jean Series'

- **Use:** Carol Jean Silene comes into color naturally almost exactly when Phlox subulata stops flowering in mid-spring. This has positioned the Silene as the "summer subulata." Flowering all season whether in the high, dry mountains of the west or the low, humid regions of the southwest, Carol Jean will be successful.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers fullsun, but may tolerate some afternoon shade. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Prefers well drained soils. Prefers even moisture, severe dry down will cause buds to fail.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6" tall and will spread into a clump of 6-12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Purple tinged foliage.
- **Flower:** Available in white or pink flowers bloom over 6 months.
