## ***Silene dioica* 'Clifford Moor' PPAF**

- **Use:** In spring and summer pink flowers emerge. Attracts bees making it an excellent addition to pollinator gardens. The outstanding feature of this plant is its attractive leaves that are dark green edged with gold. Very floriferous. Starts blooming in early Spring and continues through early Summer if cut back after initial flush. Great in rock gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers morning sun and afternoon shade, but may grow in full sun if on an irrigation system. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Prefers well drained soils.
- **Growth:** Grows 12 to 18 inches tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-9b Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Bright variegated leaves are golden (or cream in some seasons) with green centers.
- **Flower:** The pink flowers are all male, so they flower from spring to fall and drop no seeds.
