

Society Garlic



Tulbaghia violacea

- **Use:** This plant grows well in dry circumstances and makes a good rock garden or container plant. Society Garlic gives off a garlic scent and has been said to help rid gardens of mole problems.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun; moist, well drained soil. Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** A fast growing plant that forms clumps reaching 30 inches in height.
- **Hardiness:** 7 –10 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The plant has gray-green narrow leaves that are somewhat evergreen in warmer climates.
- **Flower:** The flowers are lilac in color and the plant will bloom from midsummer to early fall.
