

Happy Trails Foamflower



Tiarella 'Happy Trails' PP21933

- **Use:** Selected for its profusion of runners and charming small rounded lobed leaves that are marked with a thick black band on the veins. It's a vigorous trailer with short white flowers. Wonderful as a shade groundcover, cascading down a woodland slope, or weaving with other plants in a container or hanging basket. "Happy Trails to you..." A great groundcover for shade or in a hanging basket. Vigorous without getting out of hand. Due to the long flowering period, this perennial is very attractive in both summer and autumn. A beautiful addition to the garden, perennial border, shade garden or the rock garden. Native to North America.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers semi-shade (morning sun and afternoon shade best) and good drainage. Tolerates cold exposed locations. Good drainage is a must!
- **Growth:** Clumping foliage 4 in (9in in flower) tall, 36 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Palmately lobed, slightly hairy green leaves with black veins.
- **Flower:** Small, starry white flowers are borne on short, red, upright stems in spring. However, its major advantage above other Tiarellas is the heat tolerance. The fruit is a small lopsided capsule that splits into two segments full of shiny black seed.



Tiarellas can be grown in containers and in the landscape anywhere that dappled to full shade can be provided. They pair beautifully with hostas and ferns. Tiarellas enjoy popularity thanks to their shade tolerance, unusual leaf shape, dramatically marked foliage, repeat flowering, and light fragrance.
