- **Use:** This garden gem forms a 6-inch-high mat of dainty, ferny foliage, and is perfect for a trough or a lightly shaded nook in a rock garden. A truly low-maintenance shade native that thrives in a woodland garden. Elizabeth Oliver is a beautiful selection with a tidy clumping habit, striking red streaked leaves and delicate flowers tinged with pink. A good groundcover and a Primrose Path introduction via Charles Oliver.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers semi-shade and good drainage. Tolerates cold exposed locations;.
- **Growth:** Clumping foliage 10-12 in. tall, 12 in. wide; flower spikes 15 in. tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen here in the southern parts of its range, Striking red streaked leaves and delicate flowers tinged with pink. Foliage color intensifies in fall.
- **Flower:** It produces soft pink to white blooms in mid to late spring. Each floret has long stamens that impart a foamy or feathery appearance. The fruit is a small lopsided capsule that splits into two segments full of shiny black seed.
