

Sinonome Toad Lily



Tricyrtis 'Sinonome'

- **Use: Twinkling Jewels on Taller Stems** this unique beauty has tall stems of glossy white flowers heavily speckled with purple ruby colored spots. Foliage is shiny green, vase shaped, and quite tolerant of dry conditions for a Tricyrtis. Prized in Japan as a long stemmed cut flower. Minimal spreading. Best admired from close by, it is lovely planted near a patio or sitting area mixed with other shade perennials.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow in part shade in well-drained soil rich in organic matter. Water well on planting and regularly until established. Cut back to refresh foliage.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and 2' wide. May need staking in high shade areas.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Foliage is shiny green, vase shaped, and quite tolerant of dry conditions for a Tricyrtis.
- **Flower:** This unique beauty has tall stems of glossy white flowers heavily speckled with purple ruby colored spots. Prized as an unusual cut flower.
