Verbascum 'Dark Eyes' PP#16986

- **Use:** We are firm believers in Verbascums for every garden, and love them not only for its mix of sophisticated colors, but because it's super simple to grow & almost everblooming. One of those wonderful plants that makes you feel very successful even though you've done absolutely nothing! It's perennial too! Drought tolerant, deer AND snail resistant – you just can't go wrong!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers. Good drainage is key with Verbascum.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 8-10" tall and 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Felted gray leaves in a rosette.
- **Flower:** Produces creamy yellow flowers with dark maroon centers. Primary bloom begins in May-June and is followed by a lighter bloom period that continues into September. Remove spent flower spikes to encourage more blooms.
