

# Verbascum 'Southern Charm'



## ***Verbascum 'Southern Charm'***

- **Use:** We are firm believers in Verbascums for every garden, and love 'Southern Charm' not only for its mix of sophisticated colors, but because it's super simple to grow & almost everblooming. If you cut back spent spikes it continuously sends up new ones 24"-30" tall & is elegant with single blooms of either chamois, dusty rose or apricot, with fuzzy, purple eyes. One of those wonderful plants that makes you feel very successful even though you've done absolutely nothing! It's perennial too! Drought tolerant, deer AND snail resistant – you just can't go wrong!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 2½' -3' tall and 2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-8 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Elongate leaves.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are covered with beautiful florets in shades of buff, lavender and soft rose. Primary bloom begins in May-June and is followed by a lighter bloom period that continues into September. Remove spent flower spikes to encourage more blooms.
