

Homestead Hot Pink Verbena



Verbena 'Homestead Hot Pink'

- **Use:** Anticipate the same extraordinary blooms, as well as bloom time, as 'Homestead Purple.' , 6-10" height, heat and drought tolerance, and winter tenderness as 'Homestead Purple.' Try it with that classic purple Verbena for a showstopping color combination.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Do not water center of the plant, try to water under the leaves. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-10" tall and continues to trail 1-2' a year wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; From May to frost you can expect the same clean green foliage
- **Flower:** Over 5 months of hot pink blooms. Attracting pollinators and creating showstopping color!

Blooms for 5 months and comes back every year! Attracts butterflies.
