

Lanai Blue Verbena



Verbena 'Lanai Blue'

This fragrant easy-to-grow plant makes an excellent ground cover in landscape beds, planted in masses or mingling with other plants such as bacopa and petunias to add vibrant color.



- **Use:** Versatile! The Lanai series is award-winning recognized for its “Best in Class” performance in independent garden trials across the U.S. The self-cleaning plant tolerates heat, drought, humidity and will even take a nip of frost and still perform beautifully. It also makes great hanging baskets or containers on its own or with other plant. Butterflies and hummingbirds absolutely adore this plant as its slender stems carry clusters of colorful blooms all summer long. Like your favorite pair of blue jeans, this verbena looks great with just about anything. Dress it up with white and black or go casual with our orange and yellow flowers. Known to be deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water when top 3” of soil is dry. Do not water center of the plant, try to water under the leaves. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-10” tall and continues to trail 1-2’ a year wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, Annual, May return when given a good mulching.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous ; Green leaves have superior mildew resistance.
- **Flower:** Blue jean, fragrant flowers spring until fall. Self cleaning type.
