

Red Superbena Verbena



Verbena 'Superbena Red'

- **Use:** Superbena verbenas are vigorous and mounded, but will trail over the sides of containers. They will function as both spillers and fillers in combination planters and are best planted at the front of landscape beds. Flower and umbel size are typical for verbenas. They will bloom earlier in the season and more easily produceable in smaller containers than regular Verbenas. Attracts butterflies!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Do not water center of the plant, try to water under the leaves. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-12" tall and continues to trail 24" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Tender Perennial so will need some winter protection with mulch
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Dainty green leaves.
- **Flower:** Over 5 months (until late fall frosts) of red blooms cascade to fill baskets, a groundcover, or a filler in containers. Drives the butterflies wild!
