

Sunny Border Blue Speedwell



1993 Perennial of the year! Deer resistant and attracts butterflies.

Veronica 'Sunny Border Blue'

- **Use:** Use massed at the front of the border. The Perennial Plant Association thought so highly of this plant in 1993 that they selected it for the Plant of the Year Award. Vivid violet-blue spikes dart up above the dark green, crinkly foliage of 'Sunny Border Blue' from midsummer into fall.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to very light shade. Well-drained soil is key to successful culture.
- **Growth:** The plants are trailing, 4-6" tall and 2 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8 Perennial, Must be mulched in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Luxurious deep green foliage, long bloom period, ease of culture and minimal maintenance. It blooms are 18-24-inch stems has a long bloom season when regularly dead-headed.
- **Flower:** The violet-blue flower spikes look especially pleasing with white, pink or yellow-flowered plants.
