- <u>Use:</u> A compact Speedwell selection, ideal for near the border edge, in containers and the rock garden. This forms a low mound of attractive deep green foliage, bearing numerous spikes of rose-pink flowers starting in early summer and continuing for weeks. Prune off spent blooms to encourage more buds to form. Easy and colourful. Excellent mildew resistance.
- Attractive to but-terflies.



- Exposure/Soil: Any well drained soil in part sun will do. Dislikes extreme drought, but otherwise tough and versatile.
- Growth: Clumps reach 18 to 22 in. tall, 12 to 16 in. wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-8; Perennial,
- *Foliage:* Deciduous; long leaves
- Flower: Abundant, full spikes of rose-pink flowers continue through summer on a compact form that is perfect for border, cutting garden or container.
