

Vernique Rose Speedwell



Veronica longifolia 'Vernique Rose'

- **Use:** A compact Speedwell selection, ideal for near the border edge, in containers and the rock garden. This forms a low mound of attractive deep green foliage, bearing numerous spikes of rose-pink flowers starting in early summer and continuing for weeks. Prune off spent blooms to encourage more buds to form. Easy and colourful. Excellent mildew resistance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Any well drained soil in part sun will do. Dislikes extreme drought, but otherwise tough and versatile.
- **Growth:** Clumps reach 18 to 22 in. tall, 12 to 16 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial,
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; long leaves
- **Flower:** Abundant, full spikes of rose-pink flowers continue through summer on a compact form that is perfect for border, cutting garden or container.

Attractive to butterflies.
