

# White Water Speedwell



**Low growing groundcover with glossy green leaves on wiry stems that turn dark burgundy in the fall.**



## ***Veronica 'White Water'***

- **Use:** A delightful groundcover, forming a dense low carpet covered with dainty white flowers in spring and then in waves until frost. As weather cools, the glossy, deep green foliage takes on rich shades of bronze and burgundy, remaining evergreen in mild winter areas. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Any well drained soil in part sun will do. Dislikes extreme drought, but otherwise tough and versatile.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6" high x 18-30" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial,
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; green leaves turn burgundy in fall.
- **Flower:** Clear blue spikes from spring to fall if spent flowers are pruned.
