

# Turkish Speedwell



## *Veronica liwanensis*

- **Use:** Used in rock gardens and as ground cover, Turkish Speedwell is a spreading xeric perennial with very dark, glistening green oval leaves and cobalt blue blossoms. It forms a mat and has low water requirements once established.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Well-drained soil, so if you have red clay please amend the soil to increase drainage. Dislikes extreme drought, but otherwise tough and versatile.
- **Growth:** The plants are trailing, 1-2" tall and 15-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen leaves in mild winters are only about 1 inch long, elliptical shaped and finely toothed.
- **Flower:** Intense blue flowers with white eyes spring to early summer.

**Lots of blossoms from spring until summer!**
