

Creeping Speedwell



Lots of blossoms from spring until summer!

Veronica repens

- **Use:** Ideal for growing between flagstones or massing as a groundcover over a small area. A good cover for early spring-blooming bulbs. Easily divided by ripping apart into small pieces in spring or early fall. Tolerates moderate foot traffic.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Any well drained soil in full to part sun will do. Dislikes extreme drought, but otherwise tough and versatile.
- **Growth:** The plants are trailing, 1" tall and 2 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial,
- **Foliage:** Evergreen leaves in mild winters are only about 1 inch long, elliptical shaped and finely toothed.
- **Flower:** Tiny white flowers spring thru late summer
