## Viola 'Cool Wave Series'

- *Use:* With a true trailing habit, these elegant pansies are ready to drape fetchingly from a hanging basket or brighten up your borders. The very well-branched, prostrate and spreading plants grow vigorously, producing medium-sized blooms that hold up in rain and weather better than larger-flowered types.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full to part sun. The smaller flowering violas are more shade tolerant. Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend using a peat based soil. Require different fertilizer than most plants as they grow in the winter. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer with Nitrate not Ammonium nitrogen form of fertilizer.
- **Growth**: Grows 6" tall and cascades over pots.
- Hardiness: Perennial, but treated as an Annual as they are not attractive in the summer, but can survive with other plants shading them until fall when they will return.
- Foliage: Evergreen; dainty foliage.
- Flower: The dainty 1 1/2" flowers are edible, and welcome additions to a spring and summer salad.
