

# Capitola Calla Lily

## ***Zantedeschia 'Capitola' ('Dozanmaca')***

- **Use:** What may not be known about this plant is its adaptability. We have grown them successfully in a flower border along with other bulbs and perennials. The stems and the calyx are sturdy and long and therefore fit perfectly in bridal and exclusive bouquets.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun or at least 5-6 hours of sun. However, we have also had success with them in full sun and fairly shady locations if the soil is good. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Over watering them is a death sentence. UPON PLANTING BE SURE NOT TO OVERWATER THEM FOR THE 1ST FEW MONTHS. ALLOW TO DRY OUT SLIGHTLY BETWEEN WATERINGS.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-28" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10 perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The leaves are green with a greyed-purple margin and have a leathery texture.
- **Flower:** Dark purple colored spathes that produces numerous flowers per plant. The flower stems are about 12-14" in height.
