- <u>Use</u>: Nature meets elegance. Frozen Queen provides a spectacular effect with its deep pink blooms and translucent, white leaves. The unique hues and shapes of the variegated foliage are striking and one of a kind, making it the perfect plant to add a bold look to your space. Well known as a graceful cut flower especially in eloquent, large flower arrangements, what may not be known about this plant is its adaptability. We have grown them successfully in a flower border along with other bulbs and perennials and in pots.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Morning sun and afternoon shade (to protect from late summer burn), but at least 5-6 hours of sun. Water regularly, **BUT DO NOT OVERWATER** when top 3 in. of soil is dry. If in doubt it is best to underwater. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. **GOOD DRAINAGE IS A MUST!** WILL NOT TOLERATE RED CLAY!
- **Growth:** Grows 16-18" tall and 6-8" wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 8-10; Perennial Enjoy as a houseplant until late April and then you can plant outside.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Translucent, silvery white leaves irregularly outlined in green brush strokes elegantly twist and curve as they climb skyward.
- **Flower:** The upright, trumpet-shaped flowers, which are 4" in length and 2-3" in diameter, arrive from mid to late summer displaying the color of a good Bordeaux wine to add gorgeous contrast.
