- <u>Use</u>: Well known as a graceful cut flower especially in eloquent, large flower arrangements, what may not be known about this plant is its adaptability. We have grown them successfully in a flower border along with other bulbs and perennials.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Part sun or at least 5-6 hours of sun. However, we have also had success with them in full sun and fairly shady locations also if the soil is good. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. GOOD DRAINAGE IS A MUST! WILL NOT TOLERATE RED CLAY! If in doubt it is better to underwater them than to overwater them.
- *Growth:* Grows 18-30" tall.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 7-10 perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Long elegant foliage
- *Flower:* In spring-summer 1 1/2 2" rich peachy-orange blooms. Very good bloomer.
