

Glossy Abelia 'Francis Mason'



Abelia x grandiflora 'Francis Mason'

- **Use:** Beautiful shrub with gracefully arching branches. Useful in a border planting, as a divider or informal hedge. Spreading rounded shrub with glossy dark green leaves that sometimes tinge bronze. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 4 to 6 feet tall, 5 –6 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, but loses a few leaves. New growth bright yellow becoming golden when mature.
- **Flower:** White 3/4" fragrant flowers from summer to frost.

Long-blooming shrub.
