

Mucho Gusto® Abelia



This new variety features stable variegation with its silver-green foliage outlined by a creamy-

white margin. Its beautiful white flowers alongside the foliage will brighten up your landscape and will waft a soft fragrance all summer long.

Abelia x grandiflora 'Muadbd' USPPAF

- **Use:** You'll be pleased to make the acquaintance of Mucho Gusto abelia. This tidy, easy-care shrub brings the color and pizzazz of variegated foliage to your landscape or garden, providing color from spring through fall. It's especially nice for brightening up shady spots. In summer, it is in bloom continuously, with fragrant white flowers that attract butterflies and hummingbirds. Like other abelias, it's heat tolerant and will survive through a little dry spell.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** The tight compact habit reaches 2.5-3' tall and 3-5' wide at maturity holds a beautiful form throughout the season. Little to no pruning is required, though it may be shaped if you wish.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6 -9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. White and green variegated foliage.
- **Flower:** Produces pure white, fragrant flowers from mid summer through fall.
