- <u>Use:</u> Instant gardens are usually just a dream, but Poco Loco® Abelia can make it a reality. This low-mounded plant quickly grows to its mature size and provides color all growing season long. Its glossy foliage is a bright yellow and orange in the spring. For the rest of the season, its foliage retains a healthy green color with pink new growth, complemented by pink flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth**: The tight compact habit reaches 2' x 3' at maturity and holds a beautiful form throughout the season.
- Hardiness: Zone 6 -9; Shrub
- *Foliage*: Evergreen. Yellow & orange foliage in spring morphs into green & pink hues during summer.
- **Flower:** Fragrant pink tubular flowers appear from mid summer through fall.
