- <u>Use:</u> Rosy Charm® isn't bashful when it comes to blooming this abelia is covered in red-purple blooms starting in May and lasting until frost. With all the reliable performance qualities that make abelias a popular landscape plant drought tolerance, deer resistance, and the ability to handle heat (plus one of the more cold-tolerant abelias on the market) you'll soon succumb to this one's charms as well!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth**: Grows 6-8' tall and 7-9' wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 6b -9 Shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen. The leaves are multi-colored variegated that means they are green with gold and cream streaks up the sides. In winter those streaks turn pink on the youngest leaves. This color change is so pretty and fittingly moody for winters.
- *Flower:* Offers up flowers and fragrance that will delight you and pollinators alike, from May until fall.
