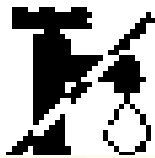


Morning Sun Cast Iron Plant



Aspidistra elatior 'Ashai'

- **Use:** This unusual beauty produces 30" tall, wide evergreen leaves, topped on the upper half with a vivid white flush. As with all plants with this much white, they are slightly less vigorous than their solid green counterparts. However, it is still great to brighten a dark spot in the woodland shade garden. Excellent for those difficult to fill areas in deep shade like under a porch or stairs. Spreads by underground stems. Deer resistant. **Super tough! Fairly drought tolerant too once established!**
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun– shade; moist, well drained soil. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Makes an attractive clump of 30" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7a-10b; Shrub; also makes a great houseplant
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The unique evergreen leaves, to 30" long x 5" wide, are set off when the upper third of the leaves develops a dramatic white variegation as the season progresses. The color holds all winter, making a dramatic winter feature in the shade garden.
- **Flower:** Insignificant brownish-purple flowers in spring.
